Witbank Hospital is a 300-bed hospital and one of three referral hospitals in Mpumalanga. The allied health section has a history of great teamwork and many clinics in the hospital as well as some of the outreach clinics are multi-disciplinary of nature. The Speech Therapy section of the department includes rendering services to hospital wards, outpatients and treating patients in various outpatient clinics i.e. CP Clinic, Autism Clinic, General Paeds Clinic, High Risk Clinic and Neuro Clinic. Community outreach for Speech Therapy and Audiology is done at various clinics, old age homes, places of safety and other hospitals – bringing services to the people.

The audiology department is equipped with ABR/ASSR, diagnostic and screening OAE equipment, two audiometers and booths for diagnostic testing, VRA equipment and tympanometer. There are various makes of hearing aids available for fitting and a Vestibular Clinic runs on a weekly basis. Neonatal hearing screening is done at the outpatient High Risk Clinic and is done at various outreach sites as part of the Community Outreach project mentioned earlier. Audiology has a good working relationship with ENT.
