This hospital is situated about 60 km from Johannesburg CBD

The Speech Therapy and Audiology Department is a newly established department. There is currently only one community service Audiologist in the department who will stay on as a permanent staff member in 2012. The therapist is responsible for service provision to all patients of the hospital, surrounding clinics and referrals from other institutions as well as management and administration tasks of the department.

Equipment and services available includes otoscope, diagnostic tympanometer (*tympanometry & acoustic reflex assessment*), 2 x 2 diagnostic booth, diagnostic audiometer (*air, bone, speech & paediatric assessments*), diagnostic OAE/ABR (*advanced electrophysiologic assessments, cerumen management equipment and PC with Hi-Pro (hearing aid programming & fittings)*).

Responsibilities includes marketing and promotion, service development and various clinical tasks in the following areas: pre & post natal wards, prem/high care unit, kangaroo mother care, paediatrics, medical & surgical wards, OPD and Ozisweni Clinic – mainly HIV/TB patients.

There are a lot of opportunities for professional development, including case presentations, multi disciplinary presentations, journal club which has been accredited for CEU points and provision of special leave to attend non-government funded courses. At our hospital we strive to provide a multi-disciplinary service to all patients who require it and specific assessments and intervention to our individual patients. The staff members at the hospital are friendly and welcoming which makes it an enjoyable institution to work at.
