Catchment areas include Mofolo, White City Jabavu, Moroka, Molapo, Dube and Meadowlands.

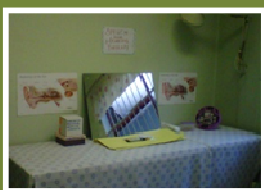


Mofolo CHC is situated about 20 km from Johannesburg CBD.

The rehabilitation team consists of a Speech Therapist and Audiologist, Occupational Therapist, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Physiotherapist and Physiotherapy Assistant. Speech Therapy Services are available at the clinic on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays where individual patients are booked on an appointment basis.

The Speech Therapist and Audiologist works closely with the other members of the multidisciplinary team, assessing and managing patients who require multidisciplinary treatment. This includes patients with stroke and head injury, cerebral palsy, autism, learning difficulties, developmental delays and intellectual disabilities. Furthermore, more individualized therapy, which includes fluency disorders, articulation and phonology treatment, language and cognition therapy, feeding and swallowing difficulties, facial palsy, hearing tests, hearing aid fittings and aural rehabilitation.

The clinic is equipped with the following audiology equipment: otoscope, screening audiometer (air-conduction only), earmould impression materials (including otolight and syringe), hearing aid repair kit (including screwdrivers, airblower, threader). There is a paediatric treatment room which is used for speech therapy with sufficient space and equipment, including puzzles, books, games, activities, craft materials and much more!



Outreach programs are done on a monthly basis to various organizations where rehabilitation services are needed. These include, stimulation centres, day care centres as well as many non profit organizations that require the services of our multidisciplinary team. Outreach is thus done together with the occupational and physiotherapist.

Home Visits are also conducted on a monthly basis whereby therapists follow up on patients in their home environment. This is also done within a multidisciplinary team.

Every second week, the Speech Therapist visits an ASHA preschool together with an occupational therapist and assistant where the children are screened for speech, hearing and occupational therapy difficulties. These children are then referred to the closest clinic, nearest to their home for the appropriate management.
