

Sizwe Tropical Disease Hospital



Sizwe Hospital is located at the Modderfontein Road, Edenvale, JHB. It is approximately 11-16 km from Johannesburg central.

116 Years later, Sizwe still renders the best service in treatment of MDR and XDR TB in the Gauteng province. History of Sizwe is filled with tremendous memories of patients like our Nobel prize winner Archbishop Desmond Tutu who occupied one of our 266 beds.



The Speech Therapy and Audiology department is situated in a building adjacent to Ward 8 which is the Allied ward consisting of Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Social Work and Psychology. In addition, there is a dietetics department located in the kitchen. There is also a hospital school for children to attend.



Sizwe caters exclusively to the treatment Of MDR and XDR TB. Service delivery includes ototoxicity monitoring for each patient, dysphagia assessment and management, speech-language individual therapy, (e.g. children or adult patients identified who require services) and speech-language group therapy (targeted at children language stimulation). Equipment includes a computer & telephone, 1x1m audio booth, standard audiometer, otoscope, hand held tympanometer, Oticon Easy-Fit and various toys & games.
