Rights: promoting, protecting and ensuring the full and equal enjoyment of all human rights and fundamental freedom.

Education: Ensuring that all disabled children and young people can fully participate in an inclusive education system.

Social Participation: Removing attitudes and environmental barriers that hinder full and effective participation in society.

Health: promoting access to the same range, quality and standards of free or affordable healthcare as provided to other persons.

Employment: promoting the right to work, on an equal basis with others, including the rights to gain a living by work freely chosen or accepted.
